



Flying With a Mikey

When any of our Mikey's Kids travel by air, we recommend they take a copy of this letter and present it to airport staff BEFORE going through security clearance.

Each airline has its own different security policies so it's advisable to call and check with them in advance before you fly.

To Whom It May Concern:

The person in possession of this MIKEY AED (automated external defibrillator) is at risk of sudden cardiac arrest, and must travel with it at all times in the event of arrhythmia.

The MIKEY AED is a device used for resuscitation only. It is a portable system that has pads attached to it and comes with a first aid kit and instructions. It is safe on airplanes as it uses a disposable lithium manganese dioxide battery.

Please note that the MIKEY AED can NOT be put through any x-ray machines as this may damage the equipment. We ask that you do not tamper with the device as this can affect its function and ability to be used as a life-saving device if needed.
